

Ried Grillenparz **1**ÖT



The appellation appeared for the first time in a document in 1180. “Grillen” is the German term for crickets. These small insects feel very safe and warm in this appellation. Grillenparz is a south exposed vineyard, formed by the typical stone terraces, which are remarkable for the viticulture in the Danube area. Very special for the Grillenparz is the soil, which consists of gneiss in the deeper parts and the compressed limestone in the upper arts. This kind of bedrock is unique in the area.
