



In the past, the high altitude of this appellation was used, to warn the city of enemies. 1137, Wartberg was documented for the first time. The name evolved to Wachtberg centuries later. High altitude, cool air streams from the north and very old vines, which root into rocky gneiss soil, add positively to the complexity of the wine.
