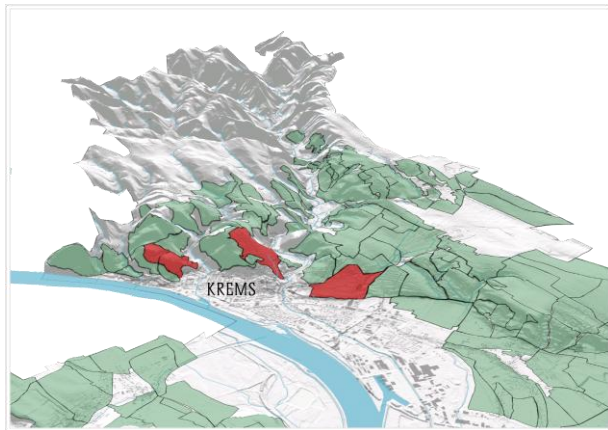


Ried Schreck



This appellation is the steepest in Kremstal. Its facing to the south and the infamous Frauenberg church. In the past, vines were planted very dense. Grape thieves could easily hide between the vines. On the church, there was a guard, who screamed from time to time, in order to scare the thieves. Schreck is a German word for scare. Blue schist is the bedrock of the vineyard, which is predestined for Riesling. The steepness requires the construction of the stone terraces to even farm the vineyard. Each work step is possible only by hand.
